Photographing Your Item

Be sure to take 10+ photos of your item (we'll use up to 8 pictures in your eBay listing). Photograph your item from all sides, and be sure to take some close-up photos of any design detail, manufacturer name, special markings, etc. You'll also need to take close-up photos of any significant scratches, dents, tears, stains or other flaws in your item, so that your item will be accurately presented on eBay. If you are using a digital camera, simply bring in your camera with the photos on the memory card. If you are using a traditional 35mm camera, have the photos developed onto a CD ROM.
